JOSEPH H. FINDLEY SCHOLARSHIP

Joseph Findley was a hockey and baseball coach at Newman Prep and Cathedral High School. He also coached the JV hockey team here at Williams for a few years in the late 50's. Mr. Findley was a founder of Babe Ruth baseball and the youth hockey program in Milton.

Mr. Findley sent a son Joseph to Archbishop Williams, class of 1961. He married a Class of 1961 graduate.

Mr. Findley passed away in 1985. This award was started at Archbishop Williams in 1995 and is also offered at B.C. High, Catholic Memorial, Cardinal Spellman, Fontbonne and Notre Dame. It is a \$2000 scholarship.

The Rocky Ryan Spirit Award

In Memory of Lt. Robert E. Ryan, USAF

Class of 1965

This award is given to a student athlete who exemplifies team leadership, good sportsmanship and who strives to help others achieve their goals. Lt. Robert E. Ryan loved Archbishop Williams. He enjoyed his four years and tried to make himself the best athlete and student that he could. He was extremely competitive and worked very hard to become the best football player that he could be. Rocky was the ultimate teammate and friend.

A graduate of the United States Air Force Academy in 1969, Rocky Ryan then went on to Lackland Air Force Base for his pilot's training. He was sent to Vietnam in January of 1971. Lt Ryan flew over 100 Viet combat missions. Tragically, his spotter plane was shot down on October 30, 1971. He was 24 years old when he died.

He is lovingly remembered by his family and friends for his ultimate sacrifice for his country, This award will be presented annually to a student at Archbishop Williams in Lt. Rocky Ryan's memory.
