On **Saturday, March 19 beginning at 8:30AM**, there will be placement tests given for Mathematics and Foreign Language. The Mathematics placement test is **required for all incoming freshmen—members of the Class of 2026**. The results of this test will help the Mathematics Department determine the correct level for your son's/daughter's Grade 9 mathematics course. Students should bring two #2 pencils. The Mathematics test will take approximately 60 minutes (untimed).

Immediately following the Mathematics placement test, a Foreign Language placement test will be given. This test is <u>only</u> for those students who will complete the equivalent of Spanish I or French I by the end of Grade 8 and are planning to take French II or Spanish II in Grade 9. This test will take approximately 45 minutes (untimed). <u>All enrolling students must return the Foreign Language form whether taking the placement exam or not. Please indicate your choice of French or Spanish on this form.</u>

It is important that these forms be completed and brought to AWHS on Saturday, March 19.
